

MYR Group Historical Timeline

1891

MYR Group began as The L.E. Myers Co. Lewis Edward Myers worked with Thomas Edison as a salesman in the late 1800's.



The L.E. Myers Co. opened for business in a small Chicago office and Mr. Myers landed his first job, a street lighting project.

1900s

Much of The L.E. Myers Co.'s work in the early 20th century was devoted to **bringing electricity to villages**, towns and rural areas, connecting them to major cities along the railways of the Midwest.



1912

MYR Group subsidiary Sturgeon Electric Company, Inc. was founded.



1940

MYR Group subsidiary Harlan Electric Company was founded.

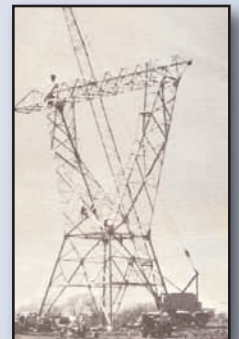


1942

During wartime, The L.E. Myers Co. worked tirelessly to **electrify defense plants and wire military installations** to maintain an uninterrupted flow of power to factories and facilities across the country.

1950s

The L.E. Myers Co. **constructed the first 345kV transmission lines** built in this country for the Ohio Valley Electric Corp.



1960s

The L.E. Myers Co. **pioneered the use of helicopters** to haul and install transmission towers throughout the rugged terrain of Kentucky.



1974

MYR constructed **one of the first 765kV transmission lines** for Commonwealth Edison Company.

1990s

2000s

2008

MYR Group Inc. (MYRG) is **publicly traded on the NASDAQ.**

2009

MYR Group subsidiary MYR Transmission Services, Inc. was founded.
